

RULES
OF THE
SOUTHWOLD READING ROOM

1. That persons of 18 years and upwards wishing to become Members shall be admitted as Probationers, until the next Quarterly meeting of Committee, at which their admission as Full Members shall be decided on.
2. That the terms for admission for Ordinary Members be at the rate of One Shilling per Quarter. Visitors are allowed to use the Room on payment of a donation, not less than 6d a week.
3. That the above Subscriptions be paid in advance and do not apply to use of the Billiard Table. The Quarter days are the 16th day of January, April, July and October.
4. That the Committee meet Quarterly, and at such other times as they may be summoned by the Secretary, and that Five form a quorum.
5. That the Room shall be Open for the use of Members on Week days, in Summer, from 6am to 10pm; in Winter, 7am to 10pm; on Sundays from 8am to 9pm, save and except as the Committee shall deem it necessary to appropriate the Room for Lectures, Readings, &c.
6. That there be no Swearing, no Gambling, no Improper Language, or Bad behaviour, and that neither Beer nor Spirits be permitted to be brought onto the Premises.
7. That no Newspaper be retained by any Member longer than 10 minutes after it has been asked for, and that no Member on any account be permitted to take any Newspaper out of the Room.
8. That no Paper shall be put on the Tables, or notices posted, without the sanction of the Hon. Secretary.
9. That the Committee have the power to eject from the Room any Member who is guilty of misconduct.
